

Guidelines and Criteria for Induction into Studentersamfundet's Hall of Fame

§1 Time Period: Studentersamfundet's Hall of Fame for volunteers applies from the General Assembly in 2012 and onwards

§2 Number of Inductees: 2-5 members are inducted annually into Studentersamfundet's Hall of Fame for volunteers

§3 Time, Location, and Form of Induction: Induction into the Hall of Fame is initiated by the outgoing board at Studentersamfundet's General Assembly, based on the established criteria

§4 Recognition: As a member of Studentersamfundet's Hall of Fame, a personalized diploma is awarded, signed by the current chairperson and the rector

§3.1 The individual is also granted a place on both a physical "Wall of Fame" in Studentersamfundet's activist room and in the virtual "Hall of Fame" on Studentersamfundet's website

§3.2 The sitting board may further award members of the Hall of Fame a gift or other form of recognition, as deemed appropriate

§5 Criteria for Induction: As a general rule, a person must have made an extraordinary effort as a volunteer at Studentersamfundet over a longer period of time in order to be considered for induction into Studentersamfundet's Hall of Fame for volunteers

§5.1 To be considered for induction, an individual must have been an active volunteer for at least 3 years during their studies at AAU

§5.2 The effort the individual has made at Studentersamfundet throughout their studies must be described as "beyond the ordinary."

§5.3 During their time at Studentersamfundet, the individual should have been active in more than one of Studentersamfundet's groups.

§5.4 An individual can still be inducted into Studentersamfundet's Hall of Fame for volunteers, even if they have been paid at some point during their time at Studentersamfundet, provided they served as chairperson, educational policy spokesperson, or student assistant. This is based on the view that the work involved in the positions of chairperson and spokesperson goes far beyond the paid role and is considered voluntary. Furthermore, it should not disqualify otherwise qualified candidates, that they have worked as a student assistant for Studentersamfundet at some point.
